Dear Judge Robinson and Quorum Court Members:

Please put the above-referenced request on the agenda for the September Committee and Quorum Court meetings.

When grant solicitations came out this year from the State, there were additional monies available for new positions. Therefore, we submitted a request to fund two new positions. One is for a Violent Crime Advocate and the other is for an Elder Victim Advocate. We were approved for these two positions at 100% funding by the grant.

These two positions will help us meet our statutory obligation to victims of crime by providing needed services along with notice requirements and better coordination with the criminal justice system.

The other good news is that we have obtained additional funding through the grants for our current victim advocate positions which will save our county \$5,684.00 per year.

I understand that I need your approval to accept these two grant positions and that is what I'm requesting at this time.

Victims of Crime are many times frustrated by what seems like a system that is only interested in the rights of the

accused. These citizens can be better served with the addition of these positions. It's a win/win for the citizens of our district because the cost to the county is zero dollars.




