2020-32 A RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, ARKANSAS APPROVING AN APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER TO THE JEFFERSON COUNTY EQUALIZATION BOARD PURSUANT TO ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED 26-27-301 THROUGH 26-27-321
