	Whereas, Jefferson County is applying for Arkansas Community and Economic Development Program funding.
	Whereas, as required by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, it shall be the policy of Jefferson County to ensure that the following are true:
	<ol> <li>The County has adopted and is enforcing this policy prohibiting the use of excessive force by law enforcement agencies within its jurisdiction against any individuals engaged in non-violent civil rights demonstrations.</li> </ol>
	II. The County will ensure that all law enforcement agencies within its jurisdiction will enforce all applicable State and local laws against physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location, which is the subject of such non-violent civil rights demonstrations within its jurisdiction.
	III. In response to non-violent civil rights demonstrations, the County will be mindful and protective of the rights of all participants in such demonstrations, as well as any onlookers, bystanders, or any other persons located in the vicinity or owning property in the vicinity.
	IV. In connection with such demonstrations, the use of force shall be permitted only when necessary to protect the rights of individuals or to uphold the law. In no event shall the use of force in excess of that necessary to achieve the lawful goals of the City or County be permitted.
	Now, therefore be it resolved that consistent with the goals and objectives of activities assisted under the Act, as amended, Jefferson County will adopt and enforce the policy contained herein.

A RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT JEFFERSON COUNTY, CERTIFYING LOCAL GOVERNENT ENDORSEMENT OF BUSINESS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TAX BACK PROGRAM (AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 15-4-2706(d) OF THE CONSOLIDATED INCENTIVE ACT OF 2003),

WHEREAS, in order to be considered for participation in the Tax Back Program, the local government must endorse a business to participate in the Tax Back Program; and

WHEREAS, the local government must authorize the refund of local sales and use tax as provided in the Consolidated Incentive Act of 2003; and

WHEREAS, said endorsement must be made on specific form available from the Arkansas Department of Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, Cornerstone Processing LLC located at 2201 W. 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, has sought to participate in the program and more specifically has requested benefits accruing from construction and equipping of the specific facility; and

WHEREAS, Cornerstone Processing LLC, has agreed to furnish the local government all necessary information for compliance.
