

Jefferson County Ordinance No. 2021- _____

Be It Ordained By the Quorum Court of Jefferson County, State of Arkansas:

An Ordinance to Establish a Special Revenue Fund to be Called the American Rescue Plan Fund, and to Declare an Emergency.

Article 1. Affirmation. Before this Court, there is a need to establish a special revenue fund on the books of the county to track the revenues, expenditures, and/or appropriated transfers of federal assistance through the American Rescue Plan Act. This Court recognizes and affirms the need for such a fund to account for properly and control all such revenues received and expenditures made in compliance with all applicable laws and guidance from the U.S. Treasury.

Article 2. Establishment of Fund. There is hereby created on the books of the Jefferson County Treasurer and the books of the Jefferson County Clerk a special revenue fund to be known as the American Rescue Plan Fund with a fund number of 3046 as assigned by Arkansas Legislative Audit. The revenue code for the federal assistance through the ARP Act, as assigned by Legislative Audit, is 7112 – Federal Coronavirus Relief.

Article 3. Operation of Fund. The American Rescue Plan Fund is subject to all the normal county budgeting, appropriation, and expenditure regulations of Arkansas Code Annotated, Title 14, and the County Financial Management System implemented in accordance with § 14-21-101. Funds must be used only in accordance with guidelines issued by the U.S. Treasury concerning the legal expenditures of revenues received pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (P.L. 11-2), which established the Federal Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund. Proper records and documentation must be maintained for federal audit purposes.

Article 4. Emergency Clause. This Court finds that the deposit of federal assistance funds from the American Rescue Plan Act is imminent, making it necessary to establish the American Rescue Plan Fund to be able to track the revenue properly, appropriated expenditures, and/or appropriate transfers. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and approval.

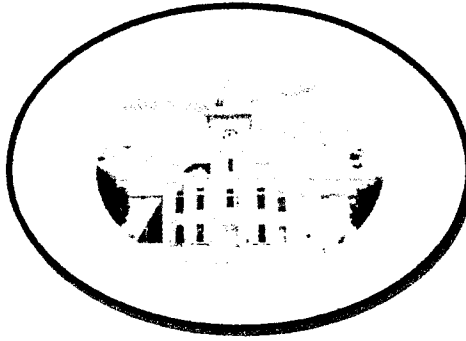

I am requesting to be placed on the agenda for the purpose of discussing the converting our real estate record system to electronic filing. The ability to file and access records electronically will be a benefit to all parties involved.

- Ease of accessing documents electronically
- Eliminate need for costly recording paper (\$3,355 yearly) and books (\$13,393 yearly)
- Reduce need for physical space
- Accessed from remote locations
- Eliminate insufficient funds and related costs

We currently have \$30,000 in the automation fund 3006 (01023003) that can go toward the \$58,000 needed to execute this program.

I have included a spreadsheet with proposed bids from 3 different land records management system companies. All bids are based on the high end of the spectrum and not tailored to our county's specific needs.

The Jefferson County Environmental Enforcement Office is requesting an Ordinance to take care of the need to establish a permit for hauling companies that utilize County Roads.

In the past, the County has had to repair roads due to hauling companies using the county roads with overweight materials. These repairs have been costly to the County and the need to establish permitting has arisen. Therefore, this office is requesting that the below guidelines should be adhered to:

A Permit to Work must be obtained through the County Road Department, at least ten (10) business days prior to any work being performed in the County. The cost of the Permit to Work is \$50.00 per site. Failure to obtain proper permitting will result in the following fines:

1st Failure- \$500.00

2nd Failure- up to \$5,000.00 no less than \$1,500.00

3rd Failure- up to \$10,000 no less than \$5,000.00


