AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PERIODIC REPORTS FROM THE VARIOUS BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OF THE COUNTY FOR REVIEW BY THE COUNTY JUDGE AND RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF JEFFERSON, STATE

WHEREAS, the public holds the County Judge accountable for the actions of county government, whether or not the action taken is by the county departments subject to the immediate control of the County Judge and Quorum Court, or is an action of one of the many county boards, commissions, task forces, or similar body; and

WHEREAS, to be informed of the activities of these bodies, and better able to respond to inquiries from the public, each body should cause to be submitted to the County Judge, regular, periodic reports setting forth the activities of the body, and any anticipated actions which will affect the community at large;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY OF JEFFERSON:

Section 1. Beginning with November 2021, each board, commission, task force, board of trustees, committee, or like the body of the county shall file a monthly report, due on the first business day of the subject month, articulating the actions taken by the body during the previous month, and including in addition to that a copy of the minutes of any meeting of the body during the month.

Section 2. Beginning in January 2022 and in January of subsequent years, each such body shall file an annual report, due no later than January 31st, summarizing the activities and accomplishments of the body for the

previous year; we are setting forth the goalsand objectives for the body for the following year, including the name of each member of the body and the expiration date of the member's term.

Section 3. Suppose the board or commission is already required by state law or local ordinance to file a monthly or annual report. In that case, that report will suffice to meet the requirements of this ordinance, except an annual report will not suffice the requirement to file a monthly report, nor does a monthly report suffices to meet the requirement of an annual report.

Section 4. The reports required by this ordinance shall be signed by the body's chair or their designee. The report shall be filed with the County Clerk.

Section 5. The reports are public records and subject to public inspection and copying pursuant to the Arkansas Freedom of Information Act.

Section 6. The sections, sentences, and phrases of this ordinance are declared to be severable, and should a section, sentence, or phrases be declared unlawful, the remaining sections, sentences, and phrases shall continue to be enforced.

Section 7. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

- Section 8. This Ordinance being of a general or permanent nature, the clerk will ensure its publication as the law requires.
- Section 9. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
