Additional Appropriation for MECA

This is a request for an additional appropriation in the amount of \$139,571.68 in the MECA 2021 budget, Fund 3403, Department 0501. This budget increase will be entirely funded by the increase in Cellular Telephone Revenue. A copy of the revised budget is attached.

The MECA Board met on February 3, 2020 and approved raises for MECA employees. A study was done to show that our dispatchers were making considerably lower than most dispatchers in surrounding counties and cities. The Board voted to raise the salaries of dispatchers by \$3000. MECA personnel in positions other than dispatcher will get a 4% increase.

In addition, the amount of money that County General will pay into MECA will be reduced from \$229,759.72 to \$227,116.14, a savings to County General in the amount of \$2,643.58.

RE: Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Site-Based Program Category 2 Grant

Greetings:

I respectfully request that the following be placed on the agenda of the Quorum Court for its March 2021 meeting.

Jefferson County has been awarded a grant through the Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration for \$285,000.00/yr. This grant has a duration of 2 years and we will be funded on a reimbursement. The turnaround to receive our money from this grant is between 3 to 5 days.

This grant will allow the Sheriff's Office to add an additional Drug Task Force Officer to help fight the opioid crisis on multiple fronts. The Sheriff's Office will be collaborating with Exodus.Life to accomplish the goals of this project. Exodus.Life is a 501c3 nonprofit seeking to expand and enhance its Exodus Academy and Continuum of Care Connection program to the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office, with the objective of addressing the needs and barriers of individuals with substance use disorders and justice involved backgrounds. Exodus.Life is one of the most effective programs in the State of Arkansas addressing the opioid epidemic with the use of peer recovery-based services.

The additional Drug Task Force Officer will respond to all Drug and overdose calls and will coordinate with the peer counselor provided by Exodus.Life to also respond to the calls. The Task Force Officer will conduct the investigation as normal of these cases while the peer review counselor will coordinate with the subject on drugs and the family to provide recovery options to these individuals. The aforementioned task are the main objective of this project. The secondary objective places peer counselors inside of the Detention Center to conduct counseling to detainees that are battling drug use. This program has a high success rate on reducing recidivism.

The requested budget is attached.



RE: Request to fill vacancies

Greetings:

I respectfully request that the following be placed on the agenda of the Quorum Court for its March 2021 meeting.

As you are aware Jefferson County Ordinance 2020-164, Article II imposes a hiring freeze on all positions of county employment for non-emergency personnel in all departments and sets out that the filling of current or future vacancies is prohibited except as provided in Article II (1). It further states that the Quorum Court may by motion exempt one or more specific appointments from application of this section upon a determination that the appointment is; (a) necessary for performance of a critical health and safety function; (b) necessary for satisfaction of a legal mandate; (c) necessary for efficient and cost-effective operation of the county; or (d) substantially funded by a federal or state grant...

On December 31, 2020 Mary Ann Wilson retired in good standing from her secretarial/clerk position (FY2020 Fund 1000-0400 Slot 16-01) assigned to the Patrol Division. This retirement has created a vacancy in that position and it has been identified that such vacancy creates a great hardship on the functions of this office. The duties that were performed by Ms. Wilson are now not able to be performed without pulling law enforcement officers from their patrol duties. Due to the staffing reductions that have happened over the previous years in the Patrol Division we cannot afford to task our law enforcement officers with additional clerical duties and expect that they remain in the field to serve as first responders to critical incidents in a timely manner. We assert that Article II (1)(c) as it states "necessary for efficient and cost-effective operation of the county" is applicable to this situation.

Our 2021 budget has been approved and funds in the amount of \$25,826.00 appropriated for Fund 1000-0400 County General-Sheriff Slot 10-5 which is that secretary/clerk position. In compliance with Ordinance Number 2020-164 I am requesting the Court's approval to fill this necessary vacancy.

Additionally, we request approval to fill vacancies in Detention Facility Maintenance, Detention Facility Cook, Detention Facility Part-Time Nurse, Juvenile Justice Facility Maintenance, Juvenile Justice Facility Cook, Juvenile Justice Facility Paraprofessional positions. Legal standards require that we must provide meals and medical services for detainees daily as well as timely repairs to the facilities for order and security. We assert that Article II (1) (a-d) of Jefferson County Ordinance Number 2020-164 are applicable to this situation, and hereby request the Court's approval to fill these necessary, but vacant, slots that the Court appropriated in the FY 2021 budget.
