2021-127 AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO COUNTY GENERAL was read. Justice Ted Harden made a motion to suspend all the rules and read the Appropriation Ordinances by Title only and move to the third reading where applicable, which was seconded by Justice Conley Byrd. Justice Ted Harden made the motion to approve, which was seconded by Justice Patricia Johnson. The Ordinance passed with a roll call vote 13 "yeas".

2021-128 AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND 3525 GANG REDUCTION INITIATIVE OF PINE BLUFF (GRIP) GRANT was read. Justice Conley Byrd made the motion to approve, which was seconded by Justice Ted Harden. Sheriff Woods spoke about the ordinance as well as Justice Conley Byrd. The Ordinance passed with a roll call vote 13 "yeas".

2021-129 AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A TRANSFER WITHIN FUND 3403 MECA was read. Justice Conley Byrd made the motion to approve, which was seconded by Justice Brenda Gaddy. The Ordinance passed with a roll call vote 13 "yeas".

2021-130 AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A TRANSFER FROM FUND 1000 COUNTY GENERAL TO FUND 3004 AMENDMENT 79 FUND was read. Justice Ted Harden made the motion to approve, which was seconded by Justice Patricia Johnson. The Ordinance passed with a roll call vote 13 "yeas".

2021-132 AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A TRANSFER WITHIN FUND 1000 COUNTY GENERAL, FUND 3000 TREASURER'S AUTOMATION, AND FUND 1819 DISTRICT COURT was read. Justice Ted Harden made the motion to approve, which was seconded by Justice Brenda Gaddy. The Ordinance passed with a roll call vote 13 "yeas".

2021-133 AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO TRANSFER AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM FUND 1812 SOLID WASTE TO FUND 1804 SOLID WASTE CONTRACT was read. Justice Patricia Johnson made the motion to approve, which was seconded by Justice Brenda Gaddy. The Ordinance passed with a roll call vote 13 "yeas".

2021-135 AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE ADDENDUM FOR THE 2022 BUDGET OF THE GENERAL FUND TO PROVIDE FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR A SALARY INCREASE FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS was read. Justice Patricia Johnson made the motion to approve, which was seconded by Justice Roy Agee. The Ordinance passed with a roll call vote 13 "yeas".

2021-136 AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE APPROVING A BUDGET FOR JEFFERSON COUNTY, ARKANSAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JANUARY 1, 2022, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2022 was read. Justice Conley Byrd made the motion to approve, which was seconded by Justice Roy Agee. There was some discussion between the Justices and other County Officials. The Ordinance passed with a roll call vote 13 "yeas".

2021-137 AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO FUND 3046 AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN was read. Justice Patricia Johnson made the motion to approve, which was seconded by Justice Brenda Gaddy. The Ordinance passed with a roll call vote 13 "yeas".

approve, which was seconded by Justice Roy Agee. The Ordinance passed with a roll call vote 13 "yeas".


