JEFFERSON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER JOB DESCRIPTION

Housekeeping Technician

The primary responsibility of this position is to ensure the detention area is kept clean and deodorized. This entails ordering janitorial supplies, keeping the bathrooms, offices, floors, etc. cleaned and maintaining a clean work environment for the detention center.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Vacuuming all carpet areas and mopping floors in the designated area.
- 2. Dusting offices and changing out trash bags.
- 3. Cleaning bathrooms and keeping them stocked with toilet paper and hand towels.
- 4. Buffing the floors in the detention area.
- 5. Keeping an accurate inventory of supplies needed.
- 6. Reporting problems encountered while cleaning the building to maintenance staff.
- 7. And may require other duties that pertain to housekeeping.

Minimum Requirements

Must have a high school diploma or equivalent. Experience in housekeeping is preferred. Effective written and verbal skills are required.

Physical Demands and Work Environment

This position requires standing, stooping and lifting for extended periods of time. It requires working in an environment where there may be exposure to aggressive and violent youth.

Notes

This position only involves the cleaning of the detention center offices in the front of the building as follows: Administrative office, Assistance Administrative office, Administrative conference room, Captain's office, School principal's office and the male and female bathrooms on the way to the Intake area. All other areas in the front of the building are the responsibility of the Juvenile Court cleaning people. This position will not allow cleaning in the pods where the juveniles are housed.

Resolution to condemn existing cable plant in the Pinebergen Area of Jefferson County, Arkansas.

WHEREAS, The County of Jefferson, Arkansas, the fact that the former cable television company operating under the name of Friendship Cable or CEBRIDGE CONNECTIONS has abandoned all of its cable plant within the Jefferson County Area referred to as Pinebergen and forfeited any rights to operate or provide a cable television service within the corporate limits of Jefferson County, Arkansas.

WHEREAS, the abandoned cable plant has not been maintained and has deteriorated to a state of disrepair so grave that it poses a danger to the residents of Jefferson County.

WHEREAS, Jefferson County recognizes the need to supply its citizens with Broadband options other than DSL and Wireless.

WHEREAS, Jefferson County has agreed to partner with Pine Bluff Cable Television to submit an Arkansas Rural Connect grant application to construct facilities for Broadband within the Pinebergen area in Jefferson County, AR.

Therefore: Jefferson County grants title to any remaining cable plant within the Pinebergen area in Jefferson County to Pine Bluff Cable Television to allow the demolition, removal, or renovation of the abandoned cable plant to allow for new facilities to be constructed to provide the citizens of the Pinebergen area in Jefferson County reliable Broadband service.

Now, therefore be it resolved by the Jefferson County Quorum Court that upon receipt of an approved Arkansas Rural Connect grant application, we agree with Pine Bluff Cable Television to remove and replace the existing, abandoned cable plant to provide Broadband service to the citizens in the Pinebergen area of Jefferson County.

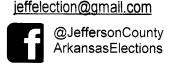

The Jefferson County Board of Election Commissioners kindly request the quorum court supplemental appropriation of \$200,000 from the general fund to Department 1000-0109-3109 Election expense to pay for conducting the June 21,2022 run-off election, the August 9, 2022 Watson Chapel School District election, and the November 8, 2022 General election. There will be two reimbursements submitted to the State Board of Elections to recover funds for May 24, 2022 primary and June 21, 2022 primary run-off expenses. Also, all expenses associated with conducting school elections will be reimbursed to the general fund.

Watson Chapel School District election will be conducted by absentee ballot, early voting, and the opening of all polling sites in the district. Funds are needed to:

- Lay out the election ballots on the Election Systems & Software (ES&S) portal.

- Absentee ballot canvass (all elections).
- Statutory election commission meeting.
- Office Supplies associated with conducting elections.

COUNTY GRANTS ADMINISTRATOR JOB DESCRIPTION

GENERAL-PURPOSE:

The Jefferson County Grants Administrator will be the County's Chief Grant Researcher and Writer. In addition, the Grants Administrator will be responsible for overseeing the County's grants management process by seeking out grant opportunities across County Departments, monitoring County Departments' compliance with grant provisions, and fulfilling the timely completion of reporting requirements for all applicable County grant programs. The Grants Administrator is responsible for managing and monitoring grants within the County, overseeing the overall grants flow process, documents, and procedures, and managing all process implementation aspects. The Grants Administrator provides clear, concise instructions on grant administration policies to grantees and staff, analyzes budget expenditure reports for assigned grants, and maintains accurate reporting for restricted grant budgets and expenditures. The Grants Administrator identifies opportunities to optimize existing grant workflow, collaborating with all county departments, maintaining and verifying payment records, reviewing invoices, receipts, and all other duties as assigned.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Reporting to the County Judge, this highly responsible professional will oversee the County's grant-seeking opportunities and funded program activities, including prioritizing, planning, and scheduling those activities to guide the County Grant Program's efficiency and effectiveness. The Grants Administrator will be required to provide support and guidance to grant support staff across departments to accomplish the required program activities.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Manages a comprehensive grant evaluation and proposal development process that results in new grant funding for the County.

MULTIMEDIA COORDINATOR JOB DESCRIPTION

General Purpose

The Multimedia Coordinator develops and implements public communications between Jefferson County and the public. This person will research, write, proofread, and edit county informational content and plan and execute public communications across various multimedia platforms. This person also performs complex administrative, research, technical and professional work in providing information to the public on a broad range of programs, services, issues, and policies across all county departments. This person reports directly to the County Judge.

Primary Responsibilities

- Develop (research, write, proofread and edit) content and communications about ongoing County projects, updates, alerts, notifications, events, upcoming issues, and press releases to be communicated to the public.
- Video/photo capture and editing for the county website and print.
- Provide applicable social media posting.
- Prepare and maintain digital and hard copy information (flyers, pamphlets, bulletins, newsletters, etc.) for Jefferson County offices.
- Plan, develop and facilitate special projects and public awareness campaigns.
- Assist with developing and disseminating communications during public emergencies.
- Other duties as assigned by Supervisor.

Essential Duties

The following is a nonexclusive list of essential duties and responsibilities for this position. The incumbent employee must be able to effectively and efficiently perform them and other duties as assigned:

- Intimately familiar with social media platforms (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, et al.)
- Photo editing includes text on photos, collaging, & lighting adjustments.
- Performs a wide range of duties such as research, assists other departments under Public Services.
- Ability to work effectively as a team member with departments throughout the county and with outside agencies as needed.
 - Ability to handle multiple projects simultaneously, effectively and efficiently.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

Skill in operation of listed tools and equipment, including typing proficiency.

- Ability to effectively meet and deal with the public; ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing using proper grammar and punctuation; ability to handle stressful situations.

- Experience working in the public sector.
- Bachelor's degree or similar established experience with specialized course work in public administration, communications, marketing, travel and tourism, public relations, or related field.
- Two years of increasingly responsible related experience, or any equivalent combination of related education and experience.
- Ability to work independently with little direct supervision.

Minimum ADA/Physical Requirements

- Sufficient clarity of speech and hearing or other communication capabilities, with or without reasonable accommodation, permits the employee to discern verbal instructions, communicate effectively on the telephone and in person, and hear equipment alarms.
- Sufficient vision or other powers of observation, with or without reasonable accommodation, permits the employee to comprehend written work instructions and review, evaluate, and prepare various written/typed documents and text materials.

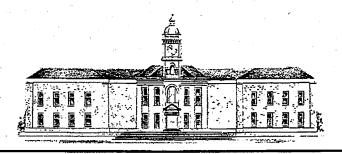
Work Environment:
